2024 Retirement Fund for Religious

Women and men religious have spent their lives serving others in prayer, ministry, education and care for those in need; usually for little or no pay, and that little to no income went to support their religious community. The Ursuline Sisters, the Sisters of the Humility of Mary, the Sisters of Notre Dame, the Oblate Sister who taught in our Catholic Schools and ministered in our parishes were supporting all the sisters in their community with what income they may have received.

Did you know that religious communities are financially responsible for the support and care of all their members? The income, earnings, and expenses are managed separately from the parish and diocesan structures of the Catholic Church and only 6% of religious communities are adequately funded for retirement. Some of the smaller communities struggle to

care for elder members due to lack of financial resources and personnel. 46% have 25 or fewer members. Rising healthcare costs and decreased income compound the challenge to meet day-to-day needs for medications, nursing assistance, and other necessities.

The collection for the Retirement Fund for Religious is the weekend of November 23-24. Our donations will help support the day-to-day care of elderly sisters, brothers, and religious order priests. This will help in their financial need as well as allowing them to continue important ministries in their retirement. Please consider contributing what you are able. Also please pray for God's continued blessings on all our women and men religious, who keep you in their prayers as well. Together, let us support the many religious women and men who have made enormous contributions to our Church and to the world.
